
Reproductive healthcare is an important part of your healthcare journey.

Our providers work with all ages and genders to help them achieve their best health. If you need contraception, reproductive health services, or well-woman visits, Good Neighbor clinics and providers can meet your needs.

Our services include:

- Birth control
- STD testing and treatment
- Pregnancy tests
- Physical exams
- PAP smears and follow-up care
- Expedited partner tests for gonorrhea and chlamydia
- HPV vaccine for persons up to age 45

- STDs often have no symptoms.
- Most STDs can be treated with medication.
- Testing is the only way to know for sure if you have an STD.
- Abstinence (not having sex) is the most reliable method of birth control and STD prevention.



- Human papillomavirus (HPV) is the most common STI in the U.S. HPV vaccines can prevent some of the health effects of HPV.
- 1 in 5 people in the U.S. have an STD. Anyone who is sexually active can get an STD.
