- For those who qualify at our lowest income level, the base charge is \$35.00.
- The sliding fee scale is based on the Federal Poverty Guidelines.
- Our Outreach and Enrollment department has Certified Application counselors who will help you figure out the best insurance/coverage option based on your situation.
- We offer low cost transportation to and from your appointment.

- Fertility testing (Columbus only)
- Nexplanon insertion and removal
- IUD (5, 8 or 10-year)
- Depo-Provera (3 month injection)
- Various doses of birth control pills

Good Neighbor has Certified Application Counselors (CACs) who are trained and educated in the different options for healthcare insurance and other types of Nebraska state assistance.
